

Logging Onto the Internet at Riverfront Banquet Center

There is free internet available at the Riverfront Banquet Center for conference attendees in Flint. It may take two or three tries to get connected, but the service has decent speed and reliability once you are logged onto the service.

It's an easy process to get going. Here's how you can get on-line:

1. Check your internet connection options and find the "MGUEST" network.
2. Click on the link and your computer will connect.
3. Your preferred browser should then open to a web page that allows you to agree to the university's terms.
4. On the left side of that page is an oblong button – you click that button to accept the terms.
5. A white box will appear with a horizontal bar that begins to turn gray. You are now connected, but cannot access the internet until that box turns entirely gray.

According to the log-in page this gives you 12 hours of internet before you are logged off. Then you need to go through the sign-on procedure once again. However in practice, SEJ staff has found that the log-in lasts longer than 12 hours. We have been told that the 12 hour rule has been disabled for conference attendees. Your experience may vary.
